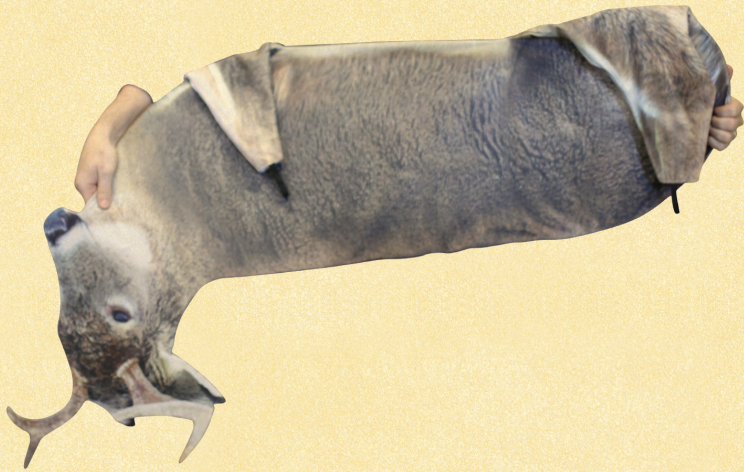
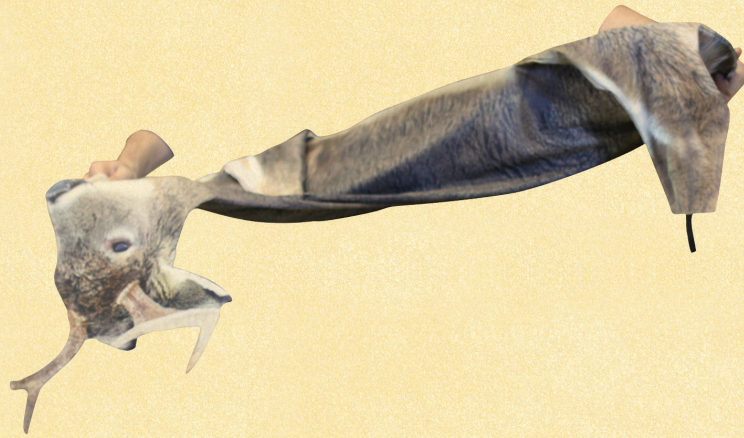


FOLDING INSTRUCTIONS

THE FRESHMAN



- 1** *START by holding the decoy horizontally out away from your body with the head down.*



- 2** *With one hand--thumb pointing up, and the other hand, thumb pointing down--twist the head with the thumb pointing up forward...*



- 3** *...and the hand with the thumb pointing down backward.*



- 4** *As you start the twisting motion, push inward like an accordion. Continue to twist and push, then cross your hands and bring the decoy into your body. The band in the decoy will form three rings...*



- 5** *...which will line up over each other as you continue twisting, locking gently into place. Congratulations! You now have a compact decoy, easy for stowing and carrying.*

POLE DIRECTIONS:

Enclosed are two leg poles; insert both poles (opposite end of the metal stake) into a sleeve sewn inside the decoy.

The sleeve opening is located in the bottom of each decoy leg. Slide the poles up into the sleeve and hook the elastic strap onto the adjustable pole clip or over the metal foot peg.

Step the pole into the ground and you're set up!
